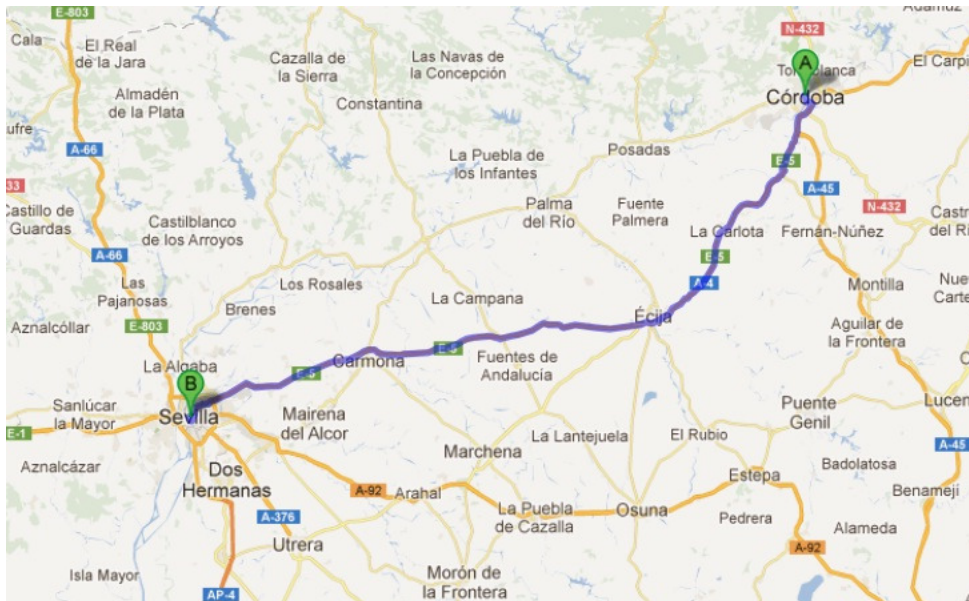


DAY 1 (15 JUN) – CÓRDOBA / SEVILLE (144KM ; 1H 45MIN)



How to get to Seville

A → B
(144Km)

- ◆ Coming from the centre of Córdoba, on **Av. de Cádiz**, take the **3rd exit** at the **roundabout**;
- ◆ At the following roundabout take the 3rd exit to follow the ramp onto **E-5 / A-4** signs for **Sevilla / Málaga**;
- ◆ Merge with **A-4**;
- ◆ Take exit **537** onto **Avd. Kansas City / Ronda Urb. Norte / E-803 / A-66 / Mérida / Sevilla Centro cuidad**;
- ◆ Merge with **Av. de Kansas City**;
- ◆ Continue following signs to **Sevilla / centro ciudad / your hotel**.

Suggestions for Sevilla

I suggest that you walk around the narrow beautiful streets of Sevilla and don't miss the best of the city.

Five things that you can't miss:

- ◆ The Cathedral and Giralda tower, one of the last remnants of the Moorish influence on Seville;

- ◆ Plaza de España - an attractive plaza near the city center. A scene from Star Wars Episode II was filmed here;
- ◆ Get lost in the Barrio Santa Cruz, stopping for tapas as you try to find your way out;
- ◆ Go to a flamenco show;
- ◆ Watch a bullfight.

Barrio Santa Cruz

Walk into this beautiful quaint barrio, the old jewish quarter, in the heart of the town. A neighborhood of narrow, cobbled alleys and streets, the barrio is filled with orange trees, colorfully tiled patios and small-scale plazas as well as a wide array of tapas bars and restaurants. Closed to vehicle traffic, the



neighborhood is perfect for visitors who want to experience the ambience of a medieval Spanish city.

Catalina Bar de Tapas

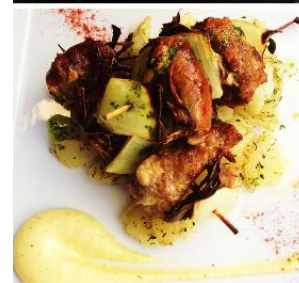
This tapas bar is known for its gourmet and creative twist on the traditional spanish tapas and half plates (raciones). Make sure not to miss on the cuttlefish - their specialty. The daily menu is written on chalkboard and the place is bustling after 9 PM (reservation is highly recommended!).
